1. During the book of I & II Kings and I & II Chronicles many wicked kings led Israel into idolatry. There were some kings who did honor and serve the Lord. Please match the kings listed below with the good deeds that they did to serve the Lord.

Joash

He repaired the temple doors and cleaned the temple of all of the idols. (II Chronicles 29-30) Was the first king to put running water into the city. (II Chronicles 32:30) God also turned the sun backward to heal him. (II Kings 20:1-11)

Josiah

Was hidden for six years and when he became king over Israel he made a covenant to serve the Lord. He wanted to repair the house of the Lord. (II Kings 11 & II Chronicles 22:8-12, 23)

Hezekiah

Was eight years old when he began to reign as king. During his reign, the Law of Moses was found and read to all the people of Judah. (II Kings 22:8-23:2 & II Chronicles 34:1-2, 14-30)

2. Because of their sins, Israel and Judah were both carried away into captivity. Israel, the ten northern tribes, was taken captive by Assyria. What happened to Judah, the two southern tribes? (II Chronicles 36:20)

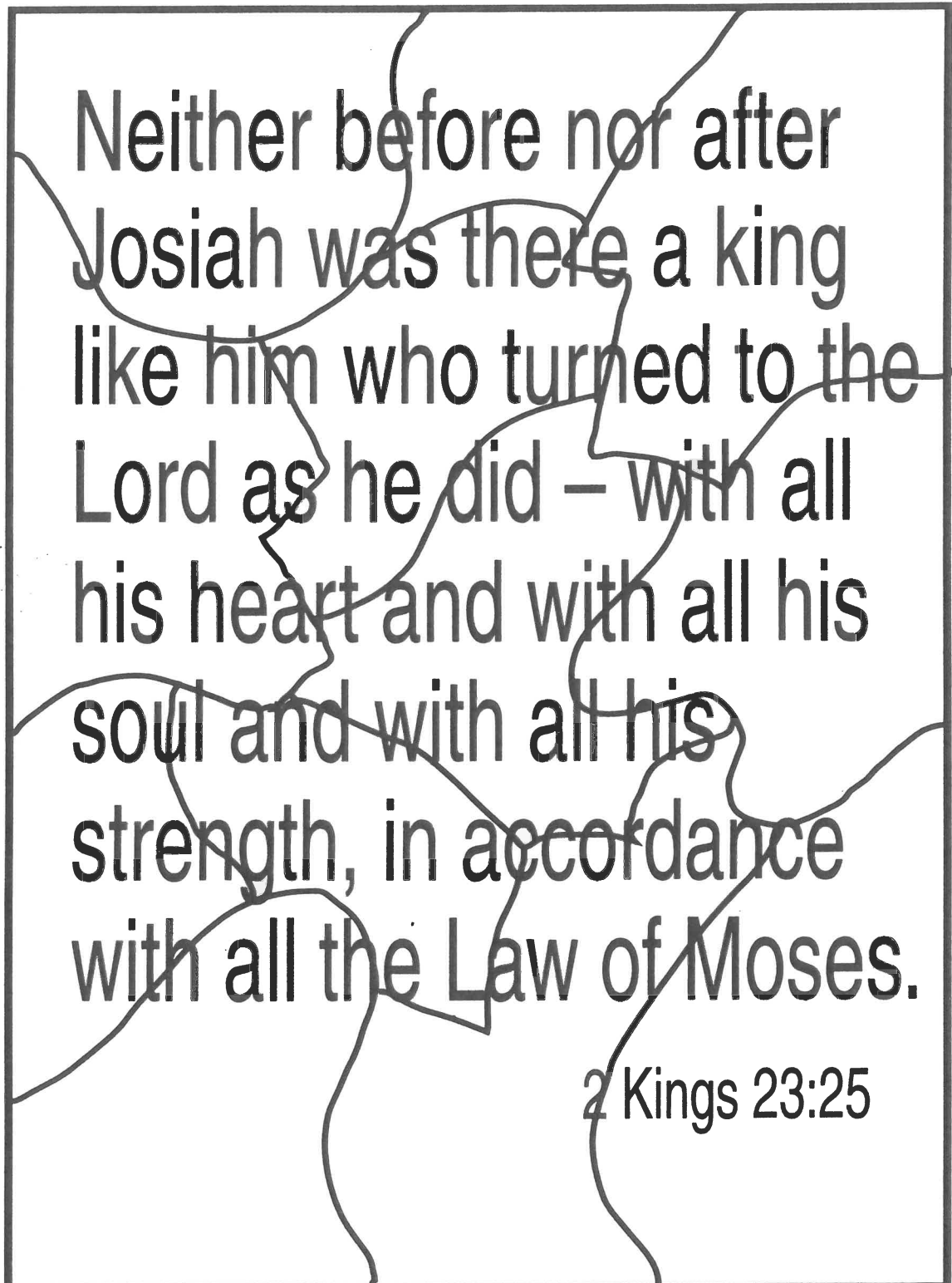

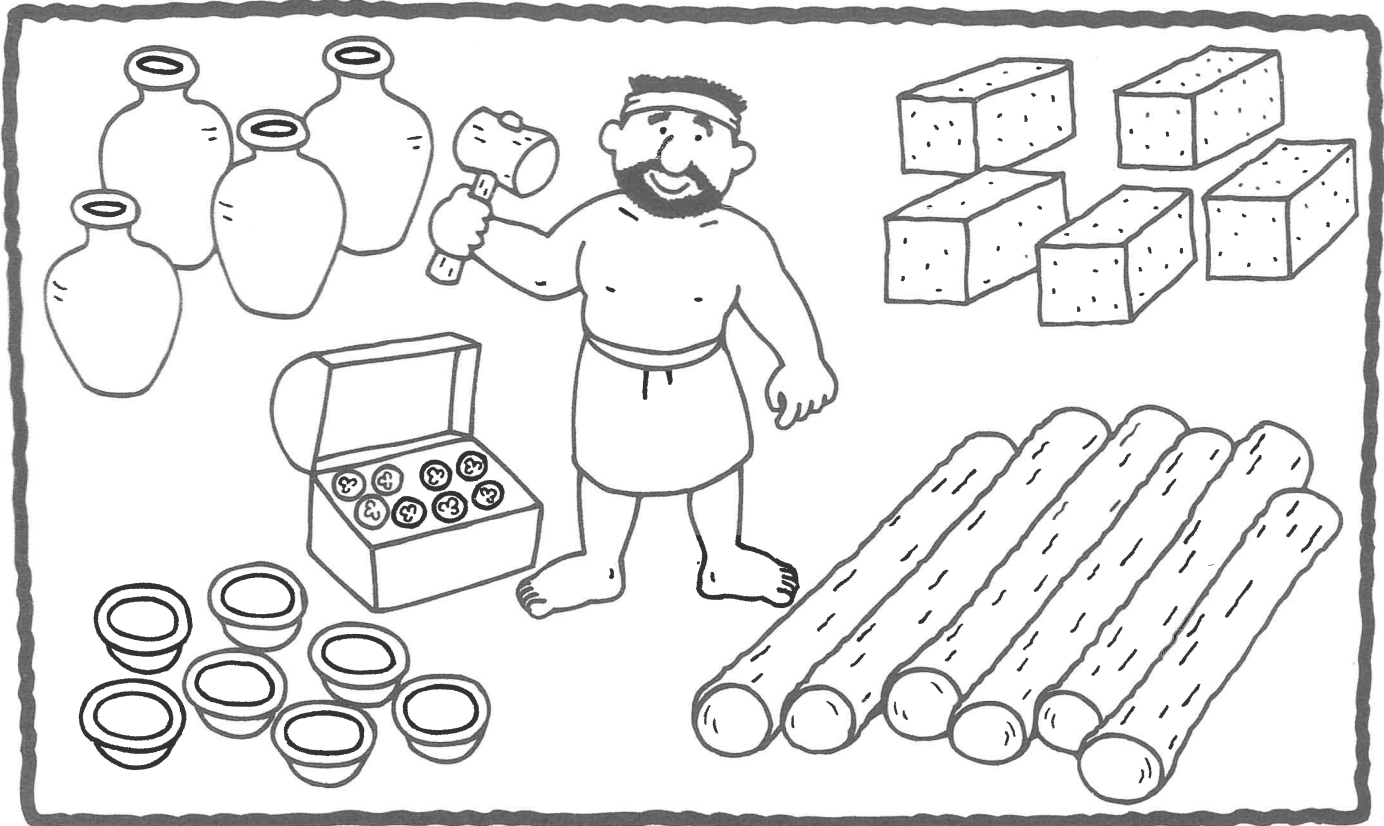

Memory Verse Puzzle

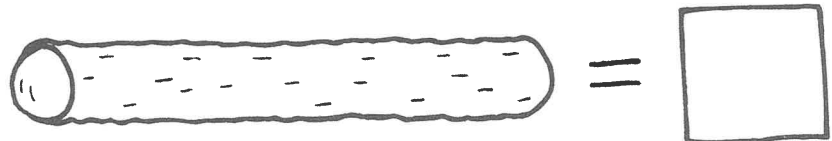
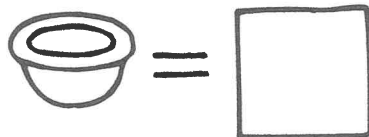
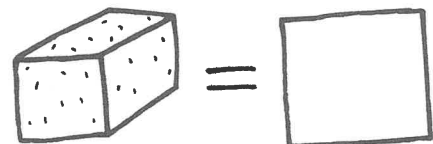
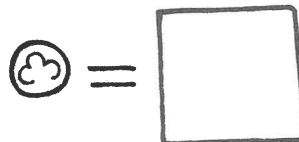
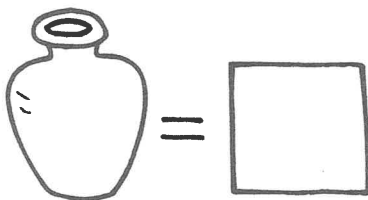
Make a copy of this puzzle for each student. Have them cut out the pieces of the puzzle, scramble the pieces and then put the puzzle back together in the right order.
