#### ***The Major Prophets – Isaiah***

**(Page 1)**

**The prophets spoke and wrote to Israel at the same time as the events recorded in the books of history, particularly after the kingdom divided following King Solomon’s death.**

- 1. Isaiah is the first book of the Major Prophets. The book begins with Isaiah seeing two visions. The first vision warns Israel about the coming destruction and captivity. What is Isaiah’s response to the second vision? (Isaiah 6)**
  - a. Isaiah runs away and hides.**
  - b. Isaiah receives a commission from the Lord. When the Lord asks, “Whom shall I send and who will go for us?” Isaiah answers, “I, Here am I, send me.” Isaiah goes to warn Israel for the Lord.**
  - c. Isaiah says that the Lord should find someone else to go to Israel and warn them.**

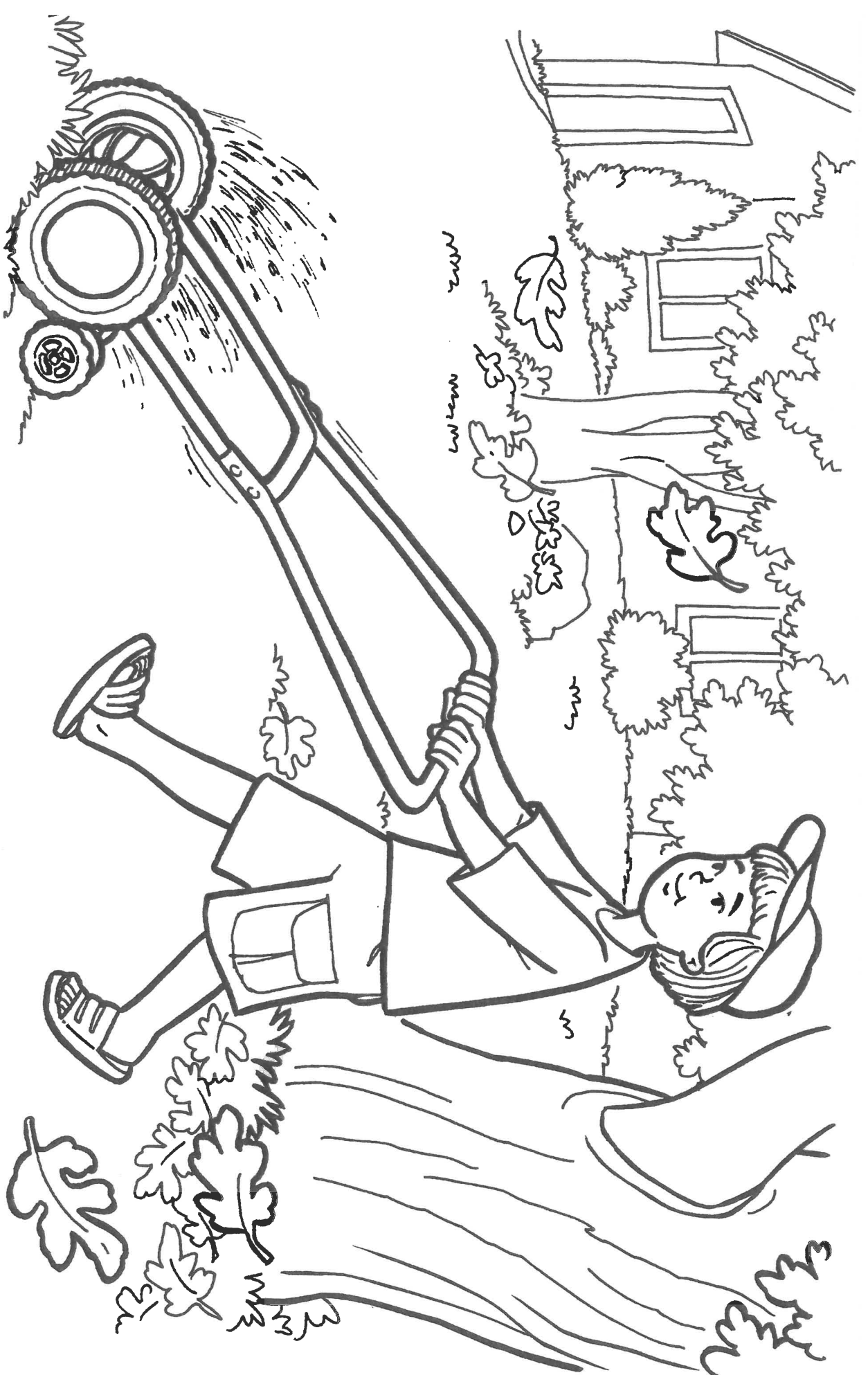
