

Rightly Dividing – Review GAME

Make three ‘signs’ with card stock and popsicle sticks that teams can hold up (one set for each team). Label signs: TIME, AUDIENCE, DOCTRINE

Divide students into teams. Give each team a set of signs.

Teams take turns drawing a question, which is a Bible verse. Teacher read the verse and asks the students how they can rightly divide this verse, by TIME, AUDIENCE or DOCTRINE.

If the team misses a question, it passes to the next team and they get a chance to answer. For extra points, the team answering correctly may explain in more detail *what* time period, *who* the audience is, *what* the doctrine is, etc.

Keep score and teach with most points at the end wins!
