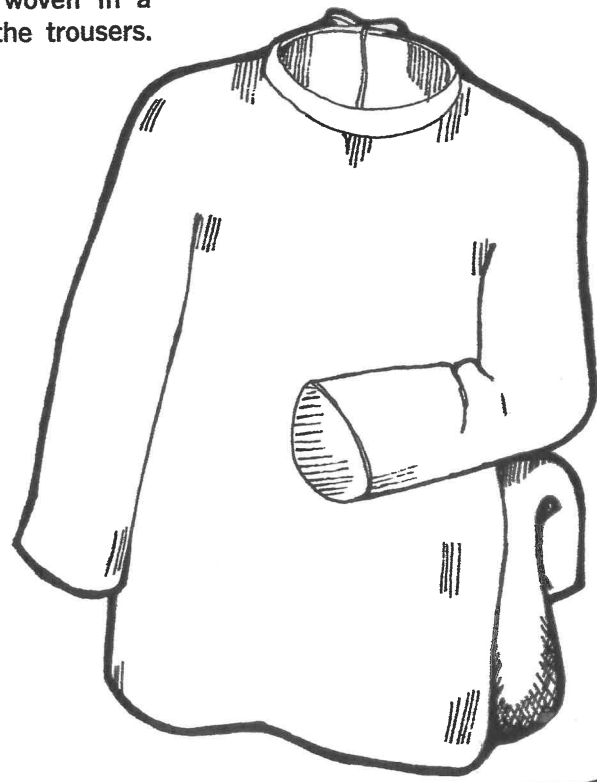
II. THE HIGH PRIEST'S CLOTHES

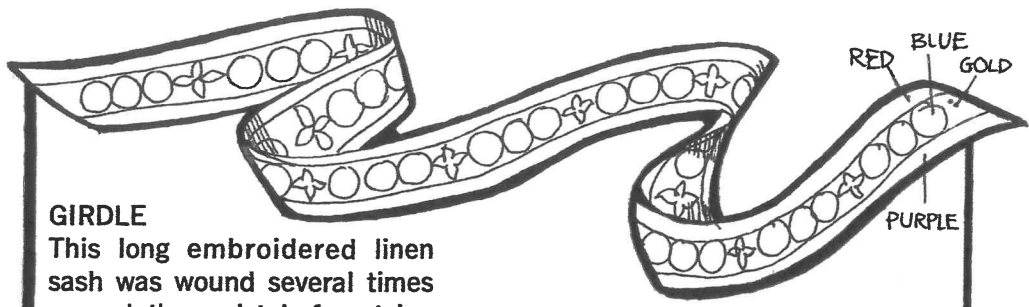
In Exodus 28 God gives some special directions for making clothes for Aaron, the high priest. Color the pieces of his clothes on these pages and when you are finished, you'll know how to color the picture of the high priest on page 17.

Short-legged linen trousers (undergarment) woven in a pattern. Tied with a piece of cloth much like a belt. *White.*



Coat (undertunic) woven in a pattern to match the trousers. *White.*





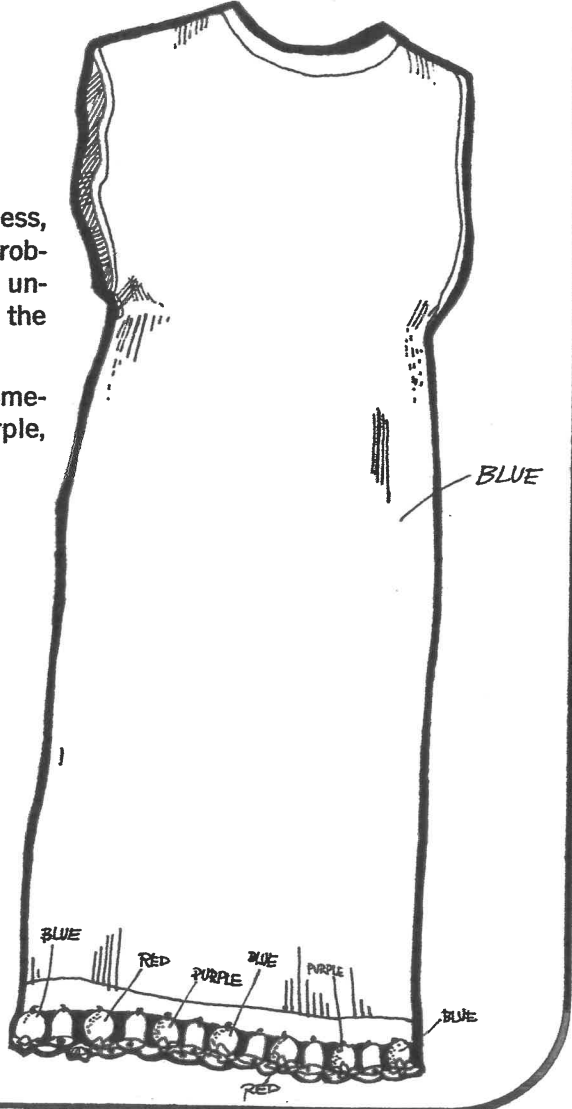
GIRDLE

This long embroidered linen sash was wound several times around the waist before tying in the front so that the ends hung down to the bottom of the coat. Probably was embroidered in blue, purple, gold, and red.

ROBE OF THE EPHOD

Outer coat, blue, sleeveless, with a border at the neck. Probably was shorter than the undertunic but longer than the ephod.

Around the bottom were pomegranates in blue, red, purple, and small bells of gold.

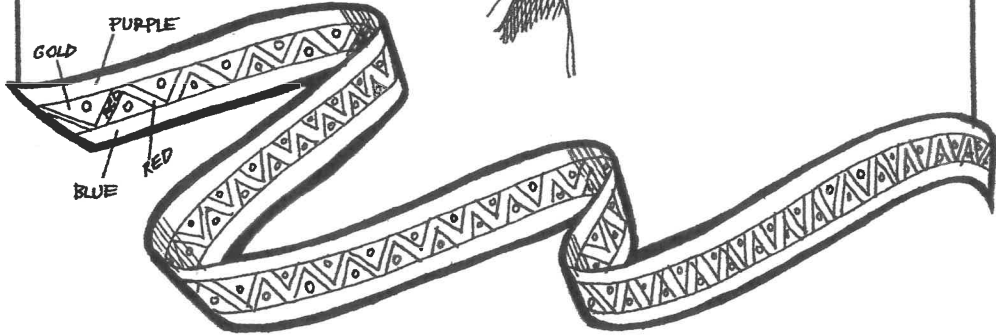
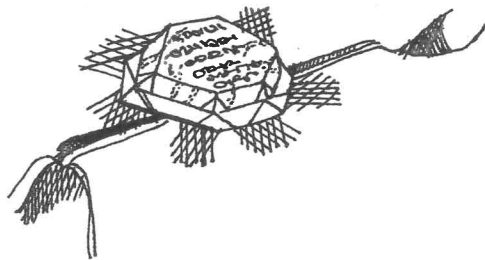
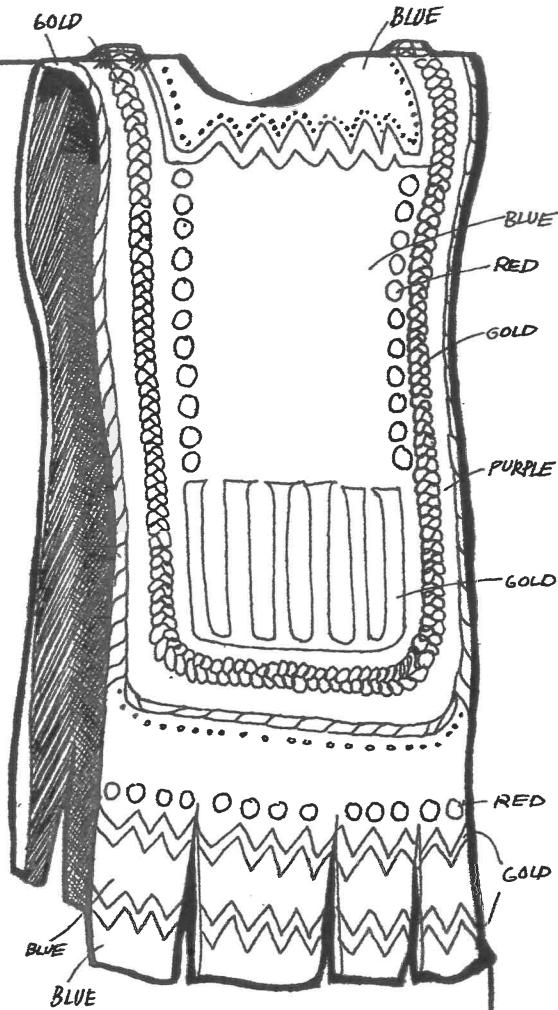


EPHOD

Two aprons, one in front and one in back. The ephod was of fine linen, with much embroidery in gold, blue, purple, and red.

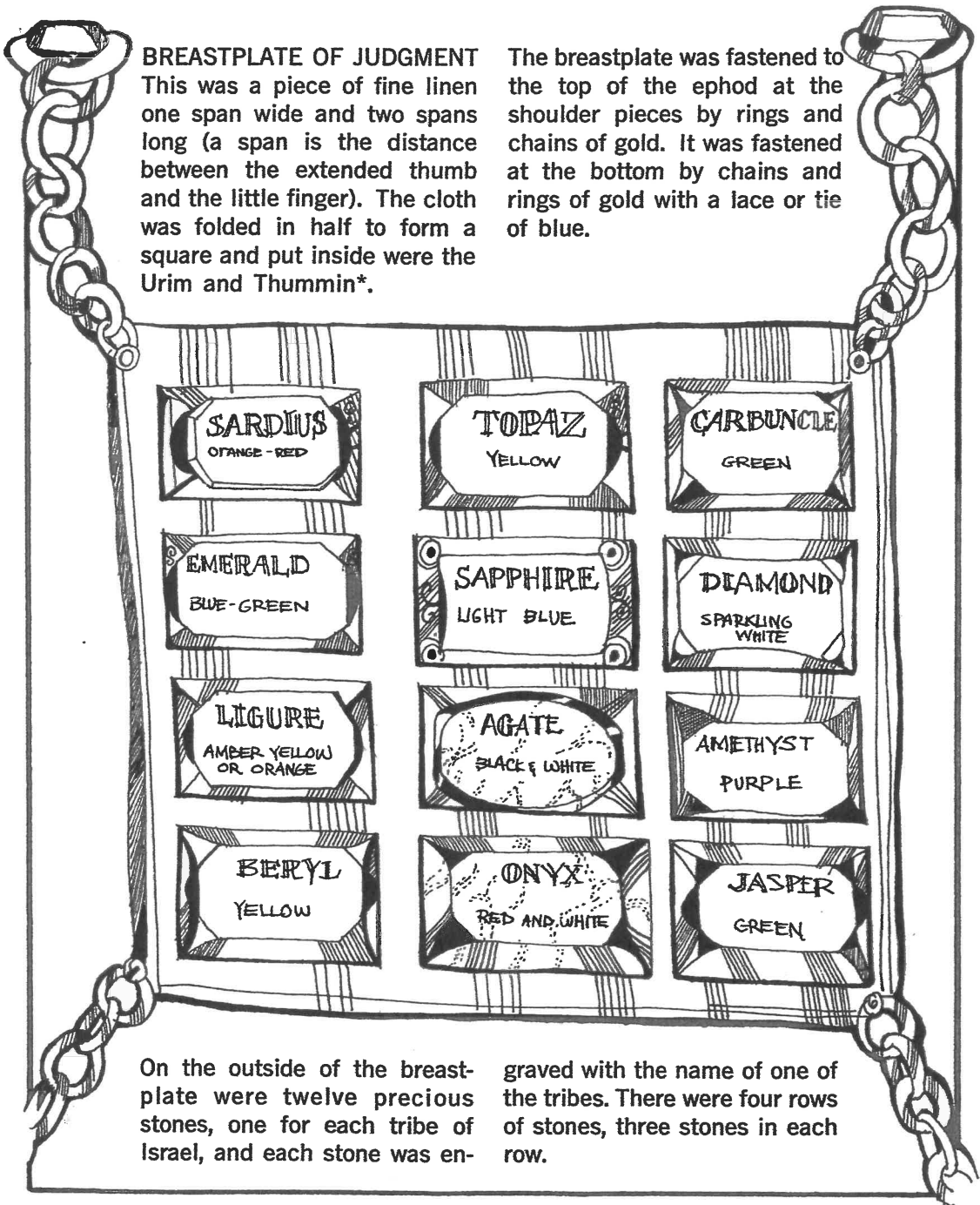
The aprons were fastened at the shoulders with a large onyx stone. Each stone was engraved with the names of six tribes of Israel and was fastened to the ephod by a little net woven of fine gold wires which were worked into the cloth of the ephod.

The aprons were tied at the middle by the "curious girdle" of the ephod made of fine blue linen cloth and embroidered in gold, blue, red, and purple.



BREASTPLATE OF JUDGMENT
 This was a piece of fine linen one span wide and two spans long (a span is the distance between the extended thumb and the little finger). The cloth was folded in half to form a square and put inside were the Urim and Thummin*.

The breastplate was fastened to the top of the ephod at the shoulder pieces by rings and chains of gold. It was fastened at the bottom by chains and rings of gold with a lace or tie of blue.



On the outside of the breastplate were twelve precious stones, one for each tribe of Israel, and each stone was en-

graved with the name of one of the tribes. There were four rows of stones, three stones in each row.

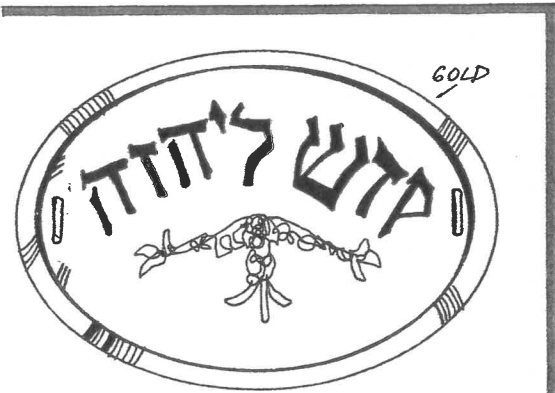

SKULL CAP

Made of white linen, worn under the mitre.

MITRE OR TURBAN

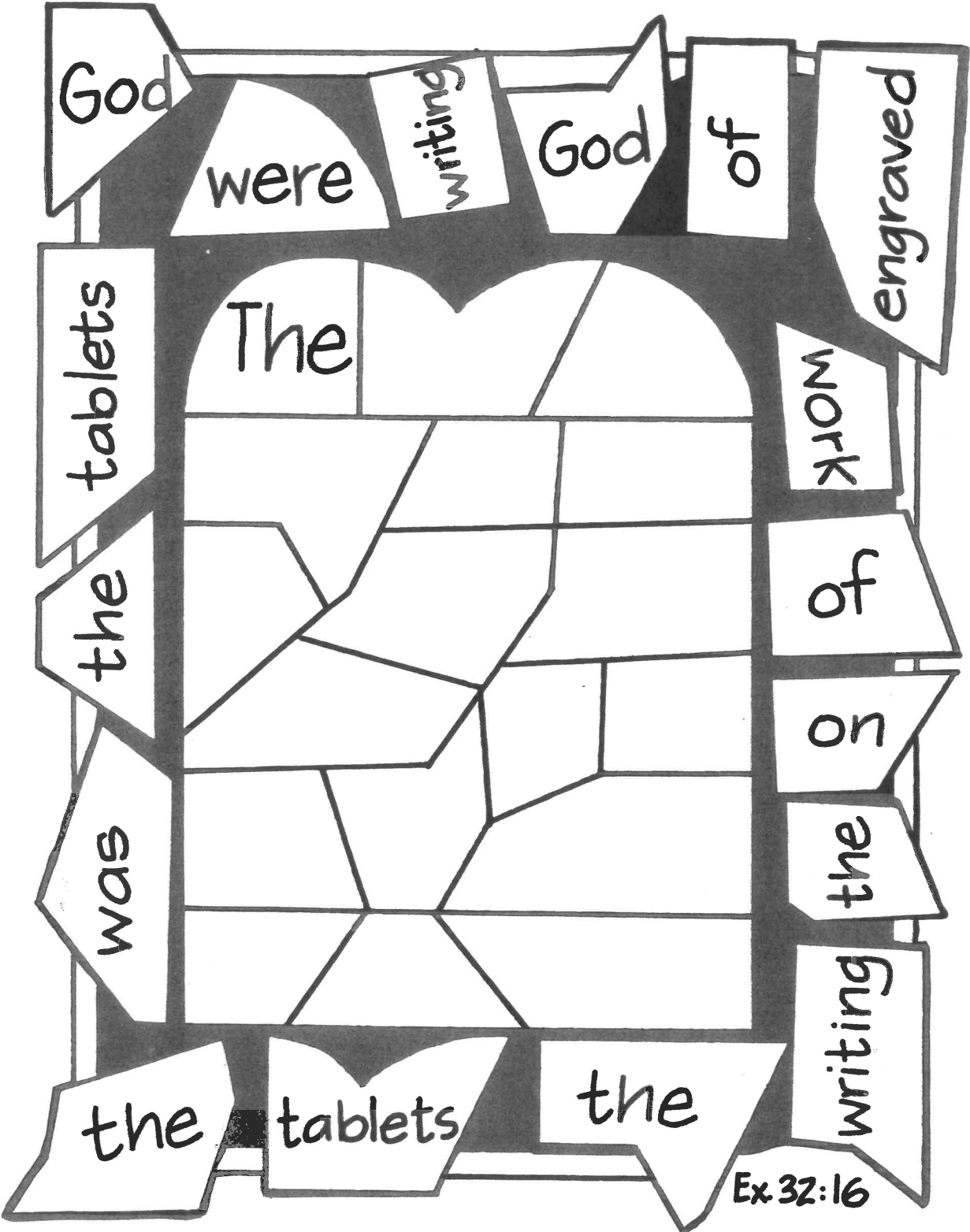
Made of fine linen. On the front of the mitre was a golden plate inscribed with the words "Holiness to the Lord." This plate was fastened to the mitre by a ribbon of blue.





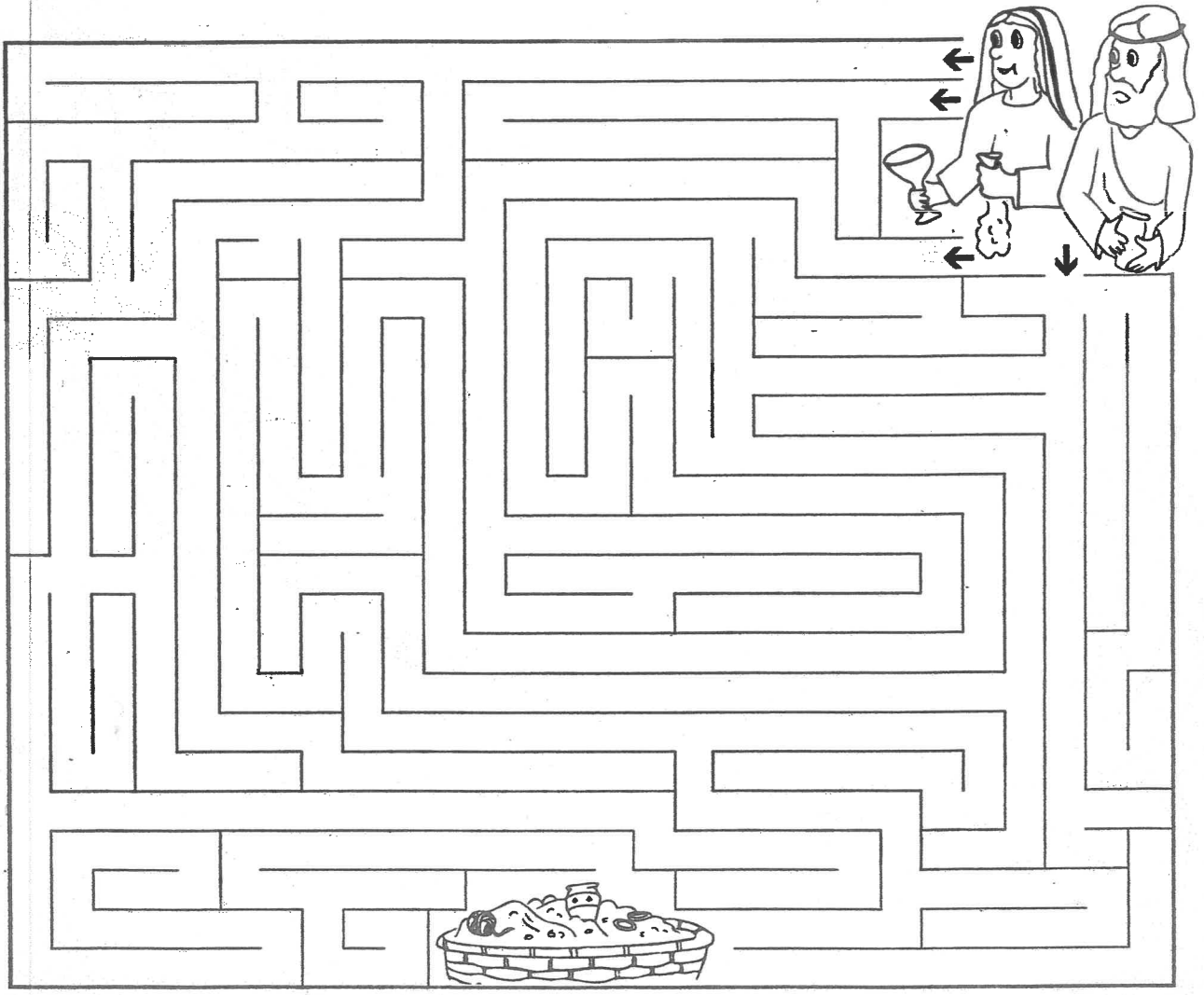

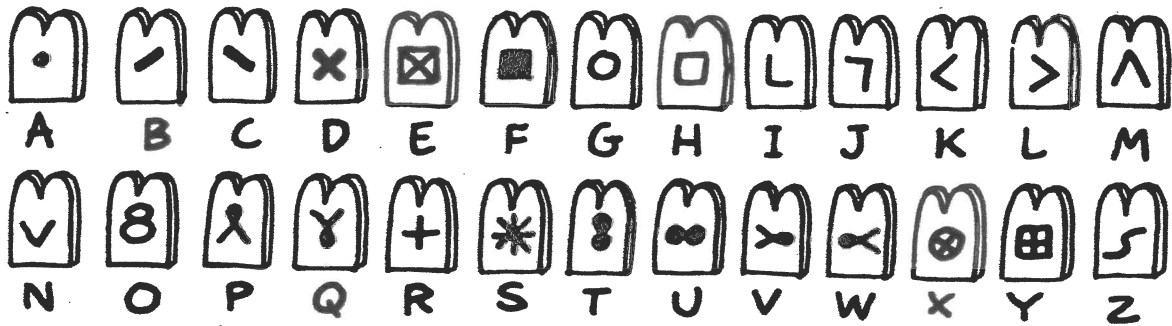
Extravagant Offering
