THE CRUCIFIXION

1. Did the leaders of Israel believe that Jesus was the Son of God?

6. Jesus was God and so death had no power over Him. After 3 days He rose from the grave. Add His empty tomb to your picture below and write above it *HE IS RISEN!* (Matthew 28:6)

Empty Tomb Rolls

Ingredients:

Tomb - 1 can crescent rolls uncooked

Spices - 1Tbs Cinnamon mixed with 1/3 cup sugar

Oils - 1-2 sticks butter melted

Jesus Body - Marshmallows regular size

Separate the crescent rolls. Lay each one out individually.

Take a marshmallow which represents Jesus body and dip it into the butter. This represents the oils they used to anoint Jesus' body. Roll the buttered marshmallow in the cinnamon/sugar mixture. This represents the spices used to anoint his body.

Place the marshmallow on the fat end of the crescent roll and roll the marshmallow in the dough all the way to the skinny end of the roll. Seal the sides so that the marshmallow is fully sealed in the dough. This represents placing Jesus' body in the tomb and sealing it. Place the rolls in a normal size cupcake pan.

Bake at 375 degrees for 15-17 minutes.

After baking let cool and have the children take a roll and open it. You will see that the tomb is empty. Jesus rose from the grave.
