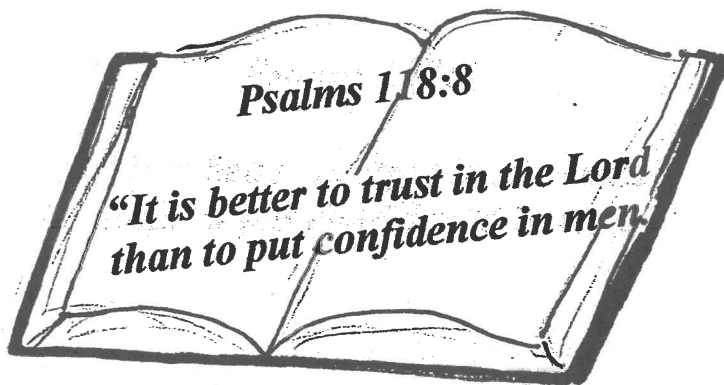
1. Sing *"The Books of the Old Testament."*
